Crécy and Agincourt

This summer we step back into the heart of medieval history with our exclusive UJC Members' tour to the historic sites of Crécy and Agincourt. We'll walk the very grounds where Kings, Knights, longbowmen and foot soldiers reshaped the art of war, in legendary encounters that defined the Hundred Years' War. Our expert guide will bring these iconic sites to life, weaving vivid stories of strategy, courage, and fate as you explore the historic French landscapes – all in great company!

Sunday, 12 July 2026

Check in at the Union Jack Club (you are welcome to use the free baggage room if you wish to arrive early).

Our tour begins in the evening where we gather at 1800 for a welcome drink and pre-tour presentation and briefing to set the scene for the next couple of days.

Following on from the presentation, a three-course dinner with a glass of wine is served and the bar will be open for extra drinks and a relax before retiring to your room for a comfortable overnight stay.

Overnight Union Jack Club

Monday, 13 July 2026

(B, L, D)

We depart from the UJC with a takeaway breakfast at 0730 and drive to Dover where we catch the 10:40 Dover to Calais ferry.

On board you will be given a voucher which entitles you to enjoy a brunch in the self service restaurant (breakfast dishes are usually served at this time).

On arriving in Calais, we head Agincourt and visit the 1415 Agincourt Museum. Following our visit to the museum, we spend the remainder of the day exploring the nearby battlefield.

Our tour of the Agincourt battlefield complete, we head to Abbeville and our overnight accommodation, the Hôtel Mercure Abbeville Centre.

After check-in and time to freshen up, we will meet in the dining room for a 3-course meal served with a glass of wine, water and coffee.

On Tuesday, 14 July 2026

(B, L, D)

After breakfast we check out and depart from the Hôtel Mercure Abbeville Centre at 09:00, and drive to Crécy-en-Ponthieu.

On arriving in Crécy, we visit the Battle of Crécy History Centre before heading out onto the battlefield.

Our tour of the Crécy battlefield complete, we begin our return journey towards Calais and back to the UK.

On arrival in Calais, we have time to enjoy a packed lunch from the hotel and spend some time discussing the Siege of Calais 1346/7 before heading to the ferry port where you will be given some time to buy snacks, gifts or wine before catching the 1635 ferry to Dover.

On board the ferry you will be given a voucher which entitles you to enjoy a dinner at the self-service restaurant.

On arrival in Dover, we head back to the UJC where our tour ends. Your scheduled arrival time at the UJC is 1900 - 1930.
